To Register

A Registration Form and \$500 deposit are required to join the trip. Once you submit your online registration (which arrives in our system with a time stamp) we will tentatively hold a spot for you. Next, we will email an invoice to you for the \$500 deposit, payable online with a credit or debit card, which you will need to pay within 24hrs. Once payment is received your spot is secure.

Note about Accommodations

Small hotels in Europe often do not have elevators. If you require a ground floor room due to luggage and/or a mobility issue, please note it on your registration. We will do our best to accommodate you. Participants should be capable of maneuvering their own luggage on cobbled streets and for walking distances as great as one mile. Suitcases should be 26" or less in height to fit in the mini-coach.



Woolen Wales *Snippet* Itinerary

Friday, April 22 | **Welcome to Wales!** Arrive Cardiff Airport, UK. It's a relaxed first day for us as we arrive in Wales. We'll visit Llancaiach Fawr Manor and then enjoy a mellow evening at our home for the next five days, Tynrhyd Retreat.

Saturday, April 23 | Recovered from our travels, we're off to spend a full day at the highly regarded festival of Welsh wool & natural fibers, Wonderwool Wales!

Sunday, April 24 Your choice of a second day at Wonderwool Wales or participating in a town & country tour of Mid Wales.

Monday, April 25 | Morning 1 of our hands-on workshops. Choose from offerings with some of Wales' most notable fiber artisans: intarsia with Sasha Kagan, wet felting with Chrissie Menzies, or tapestry weaving with Liz Beasley. In the afternoon, we'll stretch our legs with a walk to Devil's Bridge, a steam train ride to Aberystwyth and a wander along the seashore promenade to find a cozy spot for dinner.

Tuesday, April 26 | Morning 2 of our hands-on workshops. Following lunch, we're heading off to visit Garthenor Organic, a powerhouse in the UK's fiber movement. Starting with their own flock of rare breed sheep, Garthenor helped create the standards for organic wool production and now provides wool products traceable from flock to finished wearables. An optional afternoon Welsh cookery class means you might be making dinner for our merry group of travelers!

Wednesday, April 27 No visit to Wales would be complete without some time on its coast. We'll have a morning beach visit before heading on to the National Wool Museum of Wales. Later, we'll arrive at our hotel, located within the Pembrokeshire Coast National Park. The afternoon might see you involved in a spinning workshop, participating in a trail walk, or enjoying some personal time to knit, read, draw, or do as you like.

Thursday, April 28 | The day starts with the first group completing their spinning workshop while the second group explores Pembrokeshire. And in the evening... a ceilidh (party with local music and dancing).

Friday, April 29 | Switcheroo! Group two completes their spinning workshop while group one explores the area in the morning. By the afternoon, we'll be off to visit Maorbier Castle, Neath Valley Wools and enjoy a waterfall walk in the Neath Valley.

Saturday, April 30 | A full day of discovery in the Vale of Glamorgan. We'll spend time at Dyffryn Gardens, visit Ammonite Yarns and go fossil hunting on the beach. For dinner: a pub crawl through the village of Llantwit Major!

Sunday, May 1 | Head over to Cardiff Airport for our flights back home, with a heart full of memories.



Important Details to keep in mind

This trip needs at least **12** participants in order to proceed. Deposits will be refunded in the event that the tour does not operate due to lack of participants.

Travel Insurance
